NAIROBI & MOMBASA

DAY EXCURSIONS - NAIROBI

- Tours include transportation to and from JKI Airport or city hotel
- Tours do not include lunch or dinner unless noted

Nairobi City Tour

Half Day or Full Day

Half Day - Tour Nairobi's city center, National Museum and Snake Park. Experience and interact with the fascinating history, culture, nature and contemporary art of Kenya.

Full Day - Half-day tour plus tour Nairobi's city center, National Archives, Railway Museum and enjoy lunch at the Carnivore Restaurant.

Karen Blixen & Giraffe Centre

Half Day

Tour of Karen Blixen Museum, made famous by the film 'Out of Africa'. Catch a glimpse of colonial life in Kenya at the turn of the 20th century. Visit the Giraffe Center where you can feed and even kiss a Rothschild giraffe.

Carnivore Restaurant

Lunch/Dinner

Enjoy lunch or dinner at Nairobi's Carnivore Restaurant, famous for its succulent steaks, barbeque dishes and large variety of game meats – including crocodile, camel, ostrich and more. Includes transportation to/from Carnivore Restaurant.

Nairobi Shopping Experience

Half Day/Full Day

Head to the Masai Market, Westgate, Village Market, and curio shops for everything from brand name clothing and accessories to unique Kenyan crafts and souvenirs. Lunch not included.

Nairobi National Park

Half Day

Visit the city's National Park to discover Kenya's wildlife from the comfort of a minibus with a pop-up roof. View buffalo, zebra, cheetah, gazelle, leopard, lion, impala giraffe, ostrich and rhino with the skyscrapers of Nairobi's skyline in the background.

Bomas

3 hours

Enjoy the diversity of Kenya's various ethnic groups as you view traditional villages representing each group's lifestyle. Experience the traditional crafts, songs and dances of the Kikuyu, Masai, Luo and more than 30 other ethnic groups in a grand outdoor theater setting.

Daphne Sheldrick's Elephant Orphanage

3 hours

Watch orphaned young elephants from across Kenya play ball and interact with their keepers. Experience the opportunity to touch and feed these incredible animals. Also visit the blind, orphaned rhinos housed here.

NOTE: The orphanage is only open to visitors from 1100 to 1200 daily.

Kiambethu Tea Farm

4 hours (10am - 2pm)

Visit the tea fields and learn about the process of making tea at Kenya's first tea plantation. Then visit the nearby forest for an opportunity to see the Colobus monkeys that inhabit the canopy. Return to the house for drinks (beer, wine, sherry, juice, soft drinks) and a 3-course lunch.

Mombasa City Tour

Experience Kenya's culture at the historical Fort Jesus. Sundowner whilst travelling on a dhow in the old harbour. Arrive and disembark at the old town of Mombasa and walk up to Fort Jesus. At the beginning of a Sound & Light Show, you will be welcomed by Portuguese and Arabian torch carriers. Dinner, consisting of several courses, is served in Fort Jesus itself.

Pilli Pipa Dhow

Full Day

Dhow excursion from Shimoni with snorkelling in the Marine Park and lunch on an island.

Wasini Island Dhow including Kisite Marine Park

Full Day

Dhow excursion from Shimoni with snorkelling in the Kisite Marine Park and lunch on Wasini Island.

Wasini 'Fantasy Island Dhow'

Full Day

Dhow excursion from Shimoni with snorkelling outside the marine park and lunch on Wasini island. This tour is the same as ME15 except that the clients snorkel on a reef outside of the marine park.

Tsavo East

Full Day

Visit Aruba Dam with lunch at Satao Camp. Afternoon game drive to see the park's lion, elephant, rhino, leopard and more.

Kayaking Adventure on Avicennia Island

Full day or Weekend

Pickup from airport or hotel and head to Avicennia Island in Funzi Bay (40 miles south of Mombasa). Kayak through stunning mangrove forests with plenty of time for swimming or sunbathing on the sandbar. Fish for red snapper and barracuda, watch world-class birdlife, search for crocodiles on the Ramisi River, and enjoy a seafood barbeque (weekend trip only).

(Min 4 pax)

Full Day - 12 hours (Tues, Thurs, or Sat)

Weekend Trip - Pickup early Saturday morning and return Sunday evening.

Masai Mara Game Reserve

3 Days/2 Nights

Day 2 Morning and afternoon games drives in the Masai Mara, returning to the lodge for lunch. See hyenas inspecting last night's kills, elephants wallowing at the waterhole and a grassland that captures the essence of the African wilderness. Observe the zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, buffalo, lion, warthog and many other species that populate the Mara. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Day 3 Enjoy a final breakfast at the lodge, then depart for Nairobi (5 hours). Dropoff at either your Nairobi hotel or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. (B)

KS32

Amboseli National Park

3 Days/2 Nights

Day 1 Pickup from JKI Airport and drive to Amboseli National Park (3.5 hours) for lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive. Join the large herds of African elephants grazing in the swamps for a fantastic photographic opportunity. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Day 2 Enjoy a full day game drive with picnic lunches in Amboseli (or a morning and afternoon game drive if staying at Serena Lodge). With the sparse vegetation found in this arid grassland, Amboseli provides some of the best viewing opportunities in all of East Africa. During the day hours, impala, zebra, hippo and giraffe populate the expanses of the park. However, never far away are predators like the lion, hyena and jackal. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Day 3 (Early morning game drive if staying at Serena Lodge). After breakfast, depart for Nairobi (3.5 hours). Dropoff at either your Nairobi hotel or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. (B)

KS41

Lake Nakuru/Masai Mara

4 Days/3 Nights

Day 1 Pickup from JKI Airport and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park (2.5 hours) in time for lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive. Drive past the 2 million flamingos on the shores of Lake Nakuru, toward the rhinoceros, leopards, lion, cheetah and giraffe in the park. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Day 2 After breakfast, quick morning game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park before driving to the Masai Mara Game Reserve (5 hours). Arrive at the lodge for a late lunch. Afternoon game drive in the Masai Mara that offers the chance to capture all of the 'Big 5' on camera. As the sun starts to fade, predators begin to stalk the many zebra, gazelle, waterbuck, eland, antelope and buffalo in the reserve. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Day 3 Morning and afternoon games drives in the Masai Mara, returning to the lodge for lunch. See hyenas inspecting last night's kills, elephants wallowing at the waterhole and a grassland that captures the essence of the African wilderness. Lake Naivasha/Masai Mara

- Day 3 Morning and afternoon games drives in the Masai Mara, returning to the lodge for lunch. Observe the zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, buffalo, lion, warthog and many other species that populate the Mara. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Amboseli/Tsavo West

4 Days/3 Nights

- Day 1 Pickup from JKI Airport and drive to Amboseli National Park (3.5 hours) for lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive. Join the large herds of African elephants grazing in the swamps for a fantastic photographic opportunity. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 2 Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives, returning to the lodge for lunch. With the sparse vegetation found in this arid grassland, Amboseli provides some of the best viewing opportunities in all of East Africa. During the day hours, impala, zebra, hippo and giraffe populate the expanses of the park. However, never far away are predators like the lion, hyena and jackal. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 3 After breakfast, depart for Tsavo West National Park with a game drive en route. Lunch at the lodge followed by an afternoon game drive in Tsavo West. One of the largest game reserves in the world, Tsavo features large numbers of elephants and herds of buffalo numbering up to 1000. This open savannah contains eland, giraffe, monkey, warthog, zebra, impala, cheetah, lion, leopard and much more. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight. (L, D, BB)
- Day 4 Enjoy a final breakfast at the lodge, then depart for Nairobi (4 hours). Dropoff at either your Nairobi hotel or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. (B)

KS51

Aberdares/Lake Nakuru/Masai Mara

5 Days/4 Nights

- Day 1 Pickup from JKI Airport and drive to the Aberdare Country Club (3 hours) for lunch before continuing on to your lodge in the Aberdares National Park (30 minutes). Enjoy an overnight game viewing from the lodge with a floodlit waterhole for a chance to see buffalo, waterbuck, elephant, lion and baboon up-close. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L - D, BB)
- Day 2 Depart Aberdares and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park (3 hours) in time for lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive. An afternoon game drive in Nakuru. Witness over 2 million flamingos on the shores of Lake Nakuru. Be on the lookout for rhinoceros, giraffe, cheetah and a host of other wildlife found in the park before heading back to the lodge for dinner and overnight. (L - D, BB)
- Day 4 Depart after breakfast, driving past the Loita Plains and on to the Masai Mara Game Reserve (5 hours), arriving in time for lunch. In the afternoon, enjoy your first game drive in the Mara. Predators and prey abound, providing the rare opportunity to photograph all of the 'Big 5' in just a few hours. View over 70 species of large animals and 470 species of bird. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

- Day 3 Depart Samburu and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park (5.5 hours) in time for lunch at the lodge. An afternoon game drive in Nakuru. Witness over 2 million flamingos on the shores of Lake Nakuru. Be on the lookout for rhinoceros, giraffe, cheetah and a host of other wildlife found in the park before heading back to the lodge for dinner and overnight. (L - D, BB)
- Day 4 Depart after breakfast, driving past the Loita Plains and on to the Masai Mara Game Reserve (5 hours), arriving in time for lunch. In the afternoon, enjoy your first game drive in the Mara. Predators and prey abound, providing the rare opportunity to photograph all of the 'Big 5' in just a few hours. View over 70 species of large animals and 470 species of bird. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

- Day 2 After breakfast, drive to the Sweetwaters Sanctuary for lunch (30 minutes). Visit the Chimpanzee Sanctuary and enjoy an afternoon game drive through this private reserve. Lions, antelope, rhino and elephant are especially abundant here. Be sure to greet "Max" the tame Rhino. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 3 Depart after breakfast for the Samburu National Reserve (3 hours). Lunch at the lodge, then afternoon game drive. The Samburu Game Reserve is actually a collection of 3 national parks and boasts perhaps the most impressive diversity of wildlife in Kenya. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 4 Enjoy both a morning and afternoon game drive in Samburu, returning to the lodge for lunch. Keep watchful of the park's leopards, more common here than anywhere else in Kenya. Lion, cheetah, elephant, buffalo and hippo also call Samburu home. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 5 After breakfast, transfer to the Samburu Airstrip for your **scheduled flight** to the Masai Mara Game Reserve. Upon arrival, transfer to the lodge. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Masai Mara. Predators and prey abound, providing the rare opportunity to photograph all of the 'Big 5' in just a few hours. View over 70 species of large animals and 470 species of bird. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 6 Morning and afternoon games drives in the Masai Mara, returning to the lodge for lunch. See hyenas inspecting last night's kills, elephants wallowing at the waterhole and a grassland that captures the essence of the African wilderness. Observe the zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, buffalo, lion, warthog and many other species that populate the Mara. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)

Observe the zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, buffalo, lion, warthog and many other species that populate the Mara. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. (L, D, BB)
- Day 3 Early morning game drive, returning to the lodge for breakfast. Transfer to the Masai Mara Airstrip for your scheduled flight to Wilson Airport in Nairobi. Transfer from Wilson Airport to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your departure flight. (B)

MT71**Mt Kilimanjaro Trek****7 Days/6 Nights**Marangu Route

The Marangu or main route is by far the most popular way to the summit. The accommodation on the way up and down is provided in mountain huts with all the basic necessities. It usually takes 5 days/4 nights round-trip. The trek can be taken in 6 days/5 nights to add acclimatization with an extra day at Horombo Hut.

- Day 1 Pick up from Arusha town or Kilimanjaro International (JRO) Airport and transfer to Moshi town. Half board accommodation at a base hotel in Moshi.
- Day 2 After breakfast and a short tour briefing from the guide, we will depart to Marangu gate of Kilimanjaro National Park (it is a 50-min drive from Moshi to Marangu Gate). Upon registering with park authorities, our climb will officially commence with a four-hour walk to the Mandara encampment. We will pass through a thick rainforest zone, high chance of rain in the afternoon. We will spend the night at Mandara Hut (2,750m). Bathrooms are available with running water.
- Day 3 Today we will continue our ascent through the forest for a short time, before reaching the heather and moorland zone at roughly 3,000m (approx. a 6 hour walk). Enjoy stunning views of the mountain peaks at this altitude. We will spend the night at Horombo Hut (3,720m). Bathrooms are available with running water.
- Day 4 Our trek continues past the final watering point, and ascends to the saddle of Kilimanjaro, between the peaks of Kibo and Mawenzi. The vegetation thins out as we enter the desert-like alpine zone (approx. 4,000m) and, once we cross the saddle, Kibo peak comes into view. The saddle is an alpine desert that resembles a lunar landscape. Be careful to notice signs of altitude sickness. This seven-hour walk will be taken at a slow pace. We will spend the night at Kibo Hut (4,703m), a comfortable stone construction (no running water at Kibo Hut). Few plants other than lichens and grasses survive in these conditions.
- Day 5 Shortly after midnight, we will commence our climb to the summit of Kilimanjaro, since it is easier to climb the scree slope to Gillman's Point (5,861m) on the crater rim when it is frozen and an early start for the six-hour hike improves our chances of reaching the summit in time for sunrise. From Gillman's Point, it is a further two-hour round trip along the crater's edge to Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa. From the summit, it is downhill all the way to Horombo Hut where we will spend our last night on the mountain.
- Day 6 Today's descent continues past the Mandara encampment to the bottom of the mountain, where each hiker will receive a well-deserved certificate. From here, you will be transferred to a base hotel in Moshi for dinner and overnight
- Day 7 After breakfast, transfer to JRO Airport via Arusha.

Mandara Hut 2700m. This is a group of comfortable, wooden A-frame huts. The largest cabin has a downstairs dining area and upstairs dormitory with bunk beds and mattresses; smaller huts sleep 8 each. The total capacity is 60. Water is piped into the site from springs above and flush toilets are behind the cabin.

Horombo Hut 3720m. The buildings are similar to Mandara, but total capacity is 120. Water is piped from the stream behind the huts. There are platform toilets 80m down the slope and new flush toilets within the complex of small huts.

Kibo Hut 4703m. This stone house with a small dining-room & dormitory rooms has bunk beds & mattresses for 60 people.

Mt Kenya Trek**2 Routes**

Ascend Kenya's highest mountain, arriving at Point Lenana (4985m) in time to photograph the blue and orange lights that shoot over the horizon as the sun rises in the morning. Trek through wilderness that includes forests full of vegetation and hundreds of different species of birds. Elephants, buffalo, zebra and other wildlife can be seen on the lower half of the mountain. Tackle Kenya's tallest mountain for an unforgettable journey.

MT31 SIRIMON - SIRIMON ROUTE 3 Days/2 Nights

- Day 1 Depart Nairobi at 0830hrs and drive to Mount Kenya via Nanyuki town. After picking up the porters and your guide, proceed to Sirimon Gate on the northwest side of the mountain. Picnic lunches will be provided. Then make a 3 hour walk to Old Moses Hut 3300m for dinner and overnight.
- Day 2 Early morning breakfast, then start the walk to Shipton's camp. The walk takes 6-7 hours with a scenic view of the peaks Nelion and Batian through Mackinder's Valley. Arrive Shipton's camp 4200m in the early afternoon for a short rest followed by dinner and overnight. Picnic lunch will be served en route.
- Day 3 Pre-dawn attempt to trek to Pt. Lenana 4985m. Then descend directly to the road and transfer back to Nairobi (8-9 hours).

MT51 SIRIMON - CHOGORIA ROUTE 5 Days/4 Nights

- Day 1 Depart from Nairobi at 0830hrs, driving to Mt Kenya via the small town of Nanyuki. Meet your guide and porters and proceed to Sirimon Gate. Enjoy a picnic lunch before the first part of your trekking journey. Make the 3 hours walk to the Old Moses Hut (3300m) in time for dinner and overnight.
- Day 2 Rise early for breakfast and begin the march toward Shipton's Camp. This 6-7 hour walk will take you past scenic views of the Nelion and Batian Peaks. Arrive at Shipton's Camp (4200m) in the early afternoon for a brief rest, followed by a well-deserved dinner.
- Day 3 Wake up ready to reach Point Lenana (4985m). The climb begins at 2 am, allowing you to reach Lenana by 7am, in-time for the spectacular sunrise. Then descend to the Mintos Hut (4300m).
- Day 4 Descend to the Chogoria Park Gate and take dinner at the Meru Mt Kenya Bandas.
- Day 5 Descend leisurely through the Chogoria forest, enjoying the sights and sounds of the wildlife around. Connect with your driver for transportation back to Nairobi.

Day 1

Depart Nairobi at 0730 hrs, tea or coffee and biscuits are offered upon arrival at Tana River. The first 3 km consists of class II and III white water. Then experience 6 km of calm water. Take a swim and enjoy the birdlife that surrounds for approximately 1 hour. The final 7 km features class III rapids followed by 3 large class IV and IV rapids. Subject to water levels we may be able to “surf” in “fish eye” and then swim the next couple of minor rapids. Numerous smaller rapids bring us to the last big one – Spasm, a series of drops over ¾ km section with a big surprise half way through. We reach the take-out point/campsite about 4 to 5 hours after setting off, where a full barbeque lunch awaits us with beer and soft drinks included. Return to Nairobi around 1800 hrs.

Athi River White Water Rafting

3 Days/2 Nights

NOTE: Only available mid-April to mid-July. And mid-Nov to early Jan.

Day 1

After pickup in Nairobi, drive (4 hours) to Yatta Gap Bridge. 10km afternoon float down the Athi River, mostly calm section of water. Enjoy the wildlife and scenery along the edges of the river. Crocodile, monkey and baboon are common, along with more than 120 species of bird. Camp along the river.

Day 2

Rise early to spot the wildlife at the river’s edge. Giraffe, elephant and buffalo are frequent visitors to these parts. Then the real rafting begins, including numerous sections of class II and III white water, along with 2 big class IV drops. Lunch on one of the small islands on the river. Camp along the river.

Day 3

Early morning start. Expect a slightly more exciting day that includes larger rapids than the previous day. Sections of jungle will be passed though as you head downstream. Return to Nairobi in the late afternoon or opt for another night camping along the river.

At additional costs, guests can also enjoy fishing, snorkeling, kayaking, catamaran rides and other pleasant distractions at the well-equipped watersports centre. Late in the afternoon, drive back to Stone Town. Overnight at the hotel in Stone Town.
- Day 4 After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight back home.
