General Description

Keekorok Lodge lies at the southern end of the Maasai Mara Reserve. It is sited in the direct path of the annual migration and was the first lodge to be built in the Mara; it opened its doors in 1965. At the height of the migration, Keekorok is surrounded by a swarming mass of animals and there is hardly any need to go for a game drive. Keekorok's charm lies in the liberal use of local building materials. Sand stone, cedar wood and other indigenous materials are used in all rooms and public areas. A 300-meter walkway meanders through the riverine forest in front of the lodge with a small bar at one end overlooking a dam where the resident hippo, if he is not on 'walk about', finds his observers as fascinating as they find him.

 Rooms Accommodation at Keekorok is in bungalows, single storey blocks and in comfortable shaded chalets all en suite. Communication -24 hour telephone and fax service available. A radio also allows for contact between incoming aircraft and other Mara camps and Lodges. 	 Activities Hot Air Ballooning - Children under 6 years are not permitted to fly. Game Masai dancing – On alternative evenings a troupe of Masai Morans entertain guests for approximately 30 minutes.
